While on a missionary journey in Tanzania, His Beatitude Theodoros II, Pope and Patriarch of Alexandria and All Africa, was informed with regret about the passing of the Blessed Metropolitan Gennadios of Sassimon. From Arusha, His Beatitude sent the following Letter of Condolence to His All Holiness Bartholomaios the Ecumenical Patriarch:
