

HIS BEATITUDE VISITS THE EMBASSY OF EGYPT IN KHARTOUM

On the evening of 25 February 2010 His Beatitude Theodoros II, Pope and Patriarch of Alexandria and All Africa visited the Egyptian Embassy in Khartoum.
